The hindwing of the or with only a single hair-pencil, which is attached in the cell close to its anterior margin, but sometimes in the basal part with long, appressed hairs. The forewing or the hindwing in the first four species with a black mealy or velvety spot; in the fifth species the entire basal half of both wings deep velvety black.

in 2-6; the one in cellule 2 larger than the rest, which are of almost equal size; all the eye-spots are sharply prominent, black, with white pupil and with a yellow and a brown ring; before the distal margin two dark, undulate lines. 2 unknown to me.
