

722 b. **Phaio quadriguttata.** (Plate XI. fig. 16.)

Phaio quadriguttata, Dogn. Ann. Soc. Ent. Belg. liii. p. 216 (1909).

Head and thorax black, the tegulæ and shoulders with white spots; coxæ and extremities of mid and hind femora with white patches; abdomen brilliant metallic blue, the ventral surface black, a white dorsal band above and lateral and ventral white stripes except at extremity. Fore wing black suffused with metallic green, the apical area slightly irrorated with green; an elliptical hyaline spot below middle of cell, round spots in and beyond upper extremity of cell and beyond lower extremity. Hind wing black; a hyaline patch below the cell, two elongate marks beyond the cell and a small spot in fork of veins 2 and 4; the underside suffused with metallic blue.
