DEVARA, Walker.

DEVARA BUBONA, sp. n. (Plate XXXIII. fig. 6.)

Primaries dull black, with a large white patch extending from the base to about the middle, rounded on the outer edge: secondaries uniform dull black. Underside of primaries black, with the basal half white, the costal margin and apex shaded with greyish brown; secondaries silver-grey clouded with brown, the nerves all black. Head, antennæ, thorax, and abdomen black.

Expanse, $\Im 1\frac{1}{4}$ inch, $\Im 1\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Hab. Ecuador, Sarayacu (Buckley).
