NELO UXISAMA, sp. n. (Plate XXXIII. fig. 7.)

Primaries black, glossed with dark blue from the base to beyond the middle; a large spot beyond the end of the cell bright red glossed with a blue shade: secondaries deep black. Underside of primaries pale brown, with the red spot as above; secondaries pale brown, with the nerves dark brown and a small red dot at the base. Head, antennæ, thorax, and abdomen brownish black; tegulæ black, red at the base; legs black. Druce, Herbert, Proceedings of The Zoological Society, Pages: 518--536, 1885

Expanse 1½ inch.

Hab. Ecuador, Intaj (Buckley).

This beautiful species is allied to N. discalis, Walk., from Bolivia.
