

*1075 a. **Eucereon cœruleocephala.** (Plate XVIII. fig. 6.)

Heliura cœruleocephala, Roths. Nov. Zool. xix. p. 168 (1912).

♂. Head and thorax dark reddish brown, frons brilliant metallic blue with white points at sides; tegulæ at sides and shoulders with crimson spots, the tegulæ and thorax with dorsal white and metallic blue fascia; fore coxæ with white spots; abdomen very dark reddish brown, the sides and four terminal segments suffused with brilliant metallic blue, the ventral surface with white bands except at extremity. Fore wing dark red-brown, the veins and submedian fold with dark streaks. Hind wing dark red-brown, the lower part of cell, a fascia below it, and basal half of inner area semihyaline.
