

577 c. *Holophæa eurytorna*, n. sp. (Plate IX. fig. 16.)

Hind wing of male with the tornal area somewhat dilated and clothed with rough scales on underside.

♂. Head and thorax black-brown, the frons, vertex of head, and metathorax with patches of metallic green, the shoulders with crimson spots; coxæ with some metallic green; abdomen black-brown with crimson patch at base of dorsum, lateral series of metallic green bars and sublateral bars on basal segments. Wings uniform black-brown.
