*Neritos cyclopera*, Hmpsn. A. M. N. H. (7) xv. p. 446 (1905).

Antennæ of male serrate and fasciculate; fore wing with the apex produced, the termen oblique; hind wing with vein 7 from before end of cell.

♂. Palpi yellow tinged with scarlet behind and with brown spot

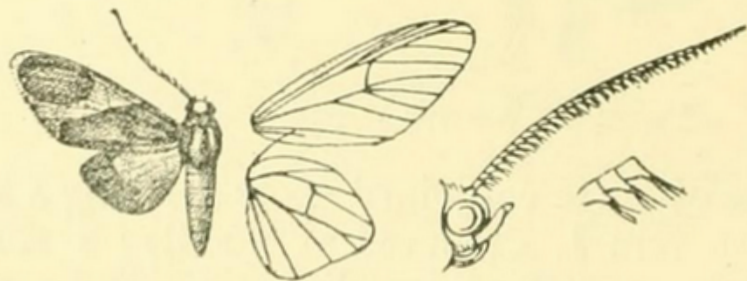


Fig. 45.—*Neritos cyclopera*, ♂. †.

yellow; thorax purple-brown; pectus and legs yellow, fore femora crimson in front; abdomen yellow, dorsally scarlet except at extremity. Fore wing with the base dark purple-brown from costa before middle to termen above tornus, its outer edge somewhat angled at lower angle of cell and vein 3; the apical area yellow with a large elliptical purple-brown subapical patch with a little scarlet above it on costa and its outer edge waved. Hind wing orange-yellow with a fuscous terminal band, extending on costa to middle, then sinuous to tornus.

*Hab.* FR. GUIANA, St. Jean Maroni (*Schaus*), 1 ♂ type. *Exp.* 30 millim.
