legs white, the fore femora tinged with crimson above; abdomen crimson, the extremity and ventral surface white. Fore wing grey-brown to costa before the middle and thence with sinuous outer edge to termen at submedian fold; some yellow at base of inner margin; the apical half of wing semihyaline yellow with a large round sub-apical brown patch tinged with purple-grey and edged with dark brown from just below the costa, on which there is a crimson streak, to just above vein 4, its edges slightly waved. Hind wing yellow tinged with crimson and with a brownish patch on terminal area from vein 3 to below vein 2; cilia yellow; the underside white with the brown patch on terminal area small.
