Overall, the iridescent blue dorsal wing colour of Lazulina gen.n. species readily distinguishes them from most euptychiines, except for females in comparison with several species of Chloreuptychia and Pseudeuptychia. Lazulina gen.n. can be distinguished by the presence of yellowish or reddish brown scaling within the dark band posterior of the VFW apical ocellus, and by the VHW ocellus in M<sub>3</sub>-M<sub>2</sub> being Espeland et al., basally displaced in comparison with that in  $M_2$ - $M_1$ .
