Group of forms: Neopithecops Dist. (1884 (Papua Röb.).

Subcostal of forewing separate. The imagines of this group of forms, comprising but one species, (P. zalmora) resemble those of Pithecops hylax so much that the earlier authors, particularly Staudinger, mixed them up. Anatomically the organs do not differ much from those of Pithecops hylax, but the almost square
