

Genus **ODOZANA.**

Odozana, Wlk. xxxi. 109 (1864) Type.
floccosa.

Proboscis fully developed; palpi porrect, not extending beyond the frons; antennæ of male with bristles and cilia; abdomen usually with lateral tufts of very long hair on 2nd and shorter tufts on terminal segments. Fore wing long and narrow; vein 2 from middle of cell; 3 from before angle; 5 from just below middle of discocellulars; 6 from below upper angle; 7, 8, 9 stalked, 7 from beyond 9; 10 from cell; 11 anastomosing with 12. Hind wing with vein 2 from beyond middle of cell; 3, 4 coincident; 5 absent; 6, 7 stalked; 8 from middle of cell.
